- A Health Fair was held on November 9, 2015. It was set up in the gym and offered basic screenings. The Saint Bernard's Mobile unit was on site to conduct mammograms. Seventeen women participated in the mammogram screenings. Stephanie Nichols will be following up to see if next year the program can offer wellness check-ups.
- The Federal Grant that Walnut Ridge, Hoxie and Imboden schools are participating in called the Farm School Grant is allowing the students to grow seasonal food on campus, to be used in the cafeteria. Currently, lettuce has been being grown. Salads with this lettuce have been being sold in the cafeteria for \$1.00. As winter approaches, the plants being grown will be cold weather plants, like broccoli and cauliflower.
